Return to School

Thursday, August 20, 2020
E-Learning Dates scheduled for August 26 and
September 2

Please select either the in-person or e-learning
option when registering for school. All students
must register for school.

COVID Positive Protocol

May return to school when:

- Minimum 10 days after symptoms first present or two
negative tests at least 24 hours apart AND
- Fever free for 72 hours without fever reducing medicine
AND
 - Other symptoms have ceased AND/OR
- Receive authorization to return from a medical provider.

Cleaning Protocols

Additional cleaning and disinfecting products and
equipment are on-site. Safe and effective cleaning
products will be regularly throughout the day in all
high touch areas. Deep cleaning will occur after
students have left for the day and on Wednesdays
during E-learning.

Other Illnesses

Students must see a provider and be fever
free to at least 72 hours without the use of
fever reducing medication prior to returning
to school.

Health and Safety Protocols

If Sick – Stay Home

Families must screen their student before school each
day. No one should enter school if s/he is not feeling
well, has a fever, or has been in contact with someone
who is ill. Sick students at school will be directed
immediately to the nurse, and a parent will be contacted.

Training

COVID-19 training will be provided for teachers and
staff on symptoms and screening measures.

Divided Health Clinic Locations

There will be an area for students displaying COVID-19
symptoms who are waiting to be picked up and another
area for medication distribution and routine health office
visits.

Masks

Students will be expected to have their mask on
them at all times and be required to wear the mask
when social distancing cannot be done
appropriately.

Masks are required at all times for all students in 3rd
and 4th grade. Masks will be required to be worn by
the K-2 students in the cafeteria serving line,
hallways, restrooms, library, and any other times
when social distance cannot be accomplished.

All staff members will be wearing masks.

Hand Washing & Sanitizing

Hand washing will be recommended and
encouraged throughout the day. Hand sanitizer will
be available in all classrooms and common areas.

School Environment Changes

Lunch choices will be limited to hot lunch or fun lunch. All items will be prepackaged and there will be no self-serve stations. All condiments and silverware will be packaged..

Only one grade level will use the cafeteria at a time with a cleaning period between each group.

We still plan on having outdoor recess but classes will be assigned a specific area to play in with their classmates for the day.

Library books will still be available for checkout and will be cleaned before they are reshelved.

All students are encouraged to bring a water bottle from home. Bottle fill stations are available.

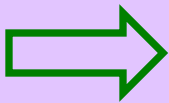
Arrival and dismissal procedures will be staggered to avoid crowded entryways.

Title 1 intervention groups will still run throughout the day but students will need to wear masks when participating in them.

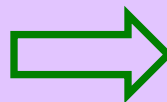
All students will utilize their own school supplies, there will be no sharing of supplies unless they can be cleaned properly between usage

Our Makerspace will be closed, but activities from the Makerspace that can be properly sanitized will be checked out to classrooms.

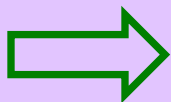
School Activities



Family/Community events will be primarily virtual or attendance will be limited to specific numbers of adults per student.

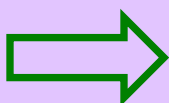

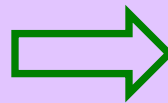


Visitors/Guests who must enter the school (ex: to pick up a student) will be limited to the lobby area and should wear a mask.

E-Learning will be run through a program called Canvas. All students will take their devices to and from school daily in the event of a closure so they can complete their e-learning at home.
